MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MoA)

between

and

Higher Education Academic Cooperation

KNOWN ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This agreement was entered into and executed on November 22, 2023, at Phnom Penh Teacher Education College, Phnom Penh, Cambodia, by and between:

Phnom Penh Teacher Education College, located at Street 271, Sangkat Teuk Laork 3, Khan Toulkork, Phnom Penh, Cambodia, hereafter referred to as **PTEC**, and represented in this instrument by **H.E. Dr. Set Seng**, Director of PTEC.

and

Universitas Negeri Padang, located at Jalan Prof. Dr. Hamka, Air Tawar, Kota Padang, hereafter referred to as **UNP**, and represented in this instrument by **Prof. Dr. Afdal, M.Pd. Kons.**, Dean of Education Faculty UNP.

- **RECOGNIZING** that academic cooperation among institutions, either through similar or complementary activities, would bring about mutual understanding and unity of purpose.

REALIZING that sharing expertise, resources, and facilities would reinforce mutually beneficial endeavors.

WHEREAS, PTEC a Public Higher Education Institution under the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sport, specializing in the areas of teacher education for both primary and lower secondary education. PTEC is envisioned to become the leading institution of teacher education in the 21st century. As the accredited higher education institution and Continuous Professional Development Provider, it aims to provide the quality Bachelor of Arts in education programs and Continuous Professional Development Programs. It also aims to promote research and publication to contribute to the quality teaching and learning. Established in 2017, PTEC is comprised of three faculties: Pedagogy and Research, Science Education, Social Science Education.

WHEREAS, UNP a PTN BH University (an autonomous and independent legal entity university) with "Excellent" accreditation (the highest accreditation level in Indonesia) Universitas Negeri Padang welcomes students from around the world to apply and engage in the university's high-quality education. Universitas Negeri Padang was the conversion of the IKIP Padang after receiving a wider mandate in 1999. The campus's long history began with the Perguruan Tinggi Pendidikan Guru (PTPG), established on October 23, 1954. Currently, UNP consists of 9 faculties, 1 Postgraduate School and 1 Vocational School. UNP's main campus is in Air Tawar, Padang, West Sumatra, Indonesia. UNP is accredited "Excellent" from BAN-PT Indonesia, and has various international accreditations such as AUN-QA, ASIIN, and AQAS. FIP UNP have 7 subjects.

Article 1 General Stipulation

In this Memorandum of Agreement, the partnership between PTEC and PG PAUD PSDKU Kota Sawahlunto UNP is defined as cooperation in terms of educational development.

Article 2 Objectives

This Memorandum of Agreement is expected to enhance the institutional relationship between the two parties, enabling them to mutually contribute to human resource development and improve the quality of their institutions to meet international education standards.

Article 3 Scope

1. Lecturer and students exchange aims to gain a new academic atmosphere and share experiences and knowledge related to improving the teaching and learning process.

2. Education development and training for instructors or lecturers will be based on training needs analysis, work-based learning, and production-based education.

Article 4 Implementation

1. The specific details and further definition of the implementation of this agreement will be determined by both parties.
2. Discussions regarding the implementation of this agreement can take place between the two parties either in Padang, West Sumatera, Indonesia, or in Phnom Penh, Cambodia.

Article 5 Funding

1. UNP will coordinate with PTEC's management regarding relevant requests.
2. Both parties will share the costs for research, lecturer exchange, and community services.

Article 6 Terms

1. This Memorandum of Agreement shall be valid for a period of 5 (five) years and will take effect from the date it is signed by both parties. The agreement may be automatically extended for another term, modified, or terminated at any time, subject to mutual agreement and written approval by both parties at least 6 months prior to the termination date.
2. This Memorandum of Agreement shall be terminated if any clause or term within it is found to be in contradiction with the regulations of Cambodia or Indonesia.

Article 7 Problem Solving

Should any conflict arise between the two parties regarding this agreement, discussion and deliberation will be chosen as the means to resolve the conflict.

Article 8 NOTICE

Every notice, request, or any other communication required or permitted to be given under this MoU shall be in writing, in English, and delivered personally or sent by registered or certified post via air mail or by courier or electronic mail to the Parties at the address and electronic mail as stated below.

2. Other matters that are related but have not been addressed will be further discussed by both parties.

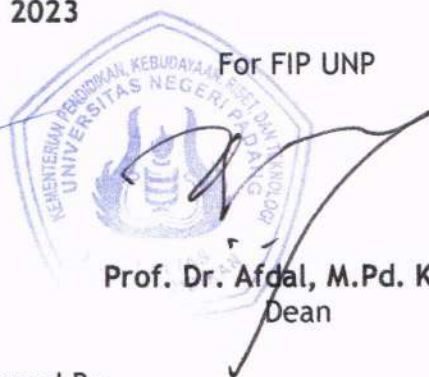
Article 10 Closing
